This workshop will be held in conjunction with the International Pervasive Health Conference, in Innsbruck, Austria, November 29<sup>th</sup> – December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006.

The objective of the workshop is to discuss **Security and Privacy** issues and challenges that are facing the healthcare professionals in the implementation of mobile technologies within the healthcare industry.

- Submitted papers

All students will have to provide proof of their status by showing their registration in a University. A letter of recommendation from their mentor/supervisor would be useful.

Papers that describe original, research work that are not published elsewhere can be submitted for this workshop. Submissions must follow IEEE's conference style two-column format including figures and references.
